ROC3: "Lift up your heads, ancient gates!"

Have you ever meditated on the scripture *your seed shall possess the gate of his enemies* (Genesis 22:17)? Ever wondered why the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel are written on the twelve gates of the New Jerusalem (Rev 21:12)? Following the completion of ROC1 (City foundations) and ROC2 (temples in the City) during 2016, the ROC3 theme revolves around the Gates of the City of Pretoria/Tshwane, with the Gates of the New Jerusalem as God's blueprint for earthly cities.

If you want to participate, you are urged to study the theme of City Gates in scripture and to join PPF for scheduled Bible study sessions. Twelve teams will be formed and each assigned to a dedicated prayer project at a specific gate of the City of Pretoria/Tshwane.
